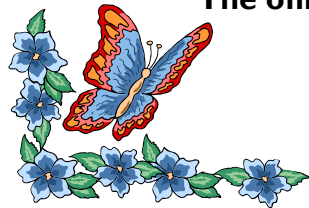

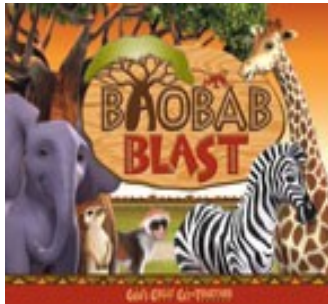
- **No Lectionary Class** this week. We will meet on June 1, 8 and 15 at 9:30 a.m. in room 14 and then will conclude for the summer.
