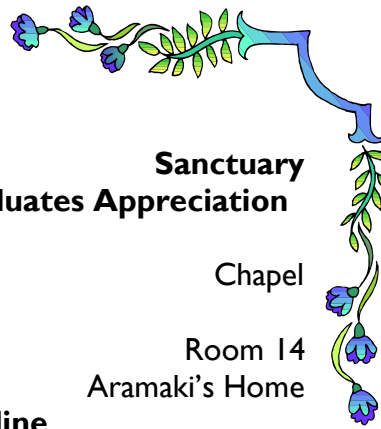

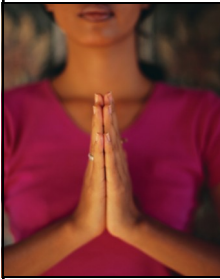

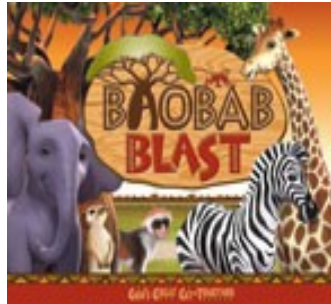
The annual Labor Day Retreat and Campout will be at Twin Harbors State Park in Westport from Friday, September 3 to Monday, September 6.
