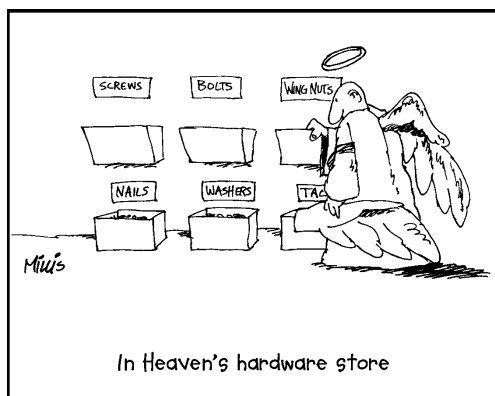

### **Prayer Concerns and Support Opportunities**

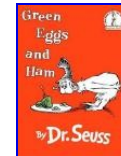
